

ATI TEAS Remediation and Retake Guidelines

Please review the following guidelines carefully if you plan to retake the ATI TEAS exam. These requirements must be followed for your application to be considered:

1. **Minimum Passing Score** – You must achieve a minimum overall score of **62%** on your retake to pass the TEAS exam.
2. **Eligibility to Retake** – You may retake the exam if you did not achieve the minimum passing score or if you wish to improve your score.
3. **Waiting Period** – A minimum of **90 days** must pass from the date of your last TEAS exam before you are eligible to retest. This waiting period is strictly enforced to ensure adequate time for study and remediation.
4. **Mandatory Remediation** – Prior to retesting, you must complete remediation/study activities. These activities demonstrate your efforts to strengthen your knowledge and skills in preparation for the retake. Documentation of these activities must be included with your remediation request.
5. **Required Remediation Form** – An **approved TEAS Remediation Form** and required materials must be approved and on file **prior** to scheduling your retake. This form documents the study activities you complete.
6. **Documentation for Application** – When submitting your nursing program application, you must include:
 - The **approved TEAS Remediation Form**
 - The official results transcript of your original TEAS exam
 - The official results transcript of your retake exam

7. **Admission Eligibility** – If you do not achieve the minimum required score of 62% on the retake, you will not be eligible for admission in the current application cycle. You may reapply during the next cycle once requirements are met.
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Important Notes on Remediation

To maximize your success, do **not** schedule your retake before completing adequate remediation and receiving the approved form.

On your remediation form, you must clearly list the specific activities you completed to prepare.

Examples include:

- Use of an official ATI TEAS Study Manual
- Participation in structured study courses, workshops, or prep classes
 - Use of online TEAS practice tests or digital prep programs
 - Independent study with other recognized TEAS study guides

We recommend the **ATI TEAS Study Manual** as a primary resource:

You may also use other TEAS study or prep guides; however, you must provide **proof of purchase or completion** of these resources when submitting your remediation form.

- The Remediation Retest Request packet must be combined into a single PDF file and saved using the following naming convention:
 - **LAST NAME, FIRST NAME – TITLE OF DOCUMENT**
 - Example:
Smith, John – TEAS Retest Request

The test offered at CR is only for test takers for the first time. If you need to re-take the test, you must contact ATI for options.

- Must include proof of progress (most often a transcript available in your ATI account) showing your improvement.

**** It is best to provide as much detailed information as possible.**

- There MUST be 90 days between each TEAS test taken or the first/earliest TEAS test score will be used.
- You MUST attach an official copy of all TEAS results.
- TEAS re-test request packet must be combined into one PDF named as stated on previous page.

REMEDICATION ACTIVITIES (REQUIRED)

I acknowledge that the plan presented has been completed. The re-test approval request is less than one year from the first/earliest TEAS test date (attach the final scores).
