

FINANCIAL AID ELIGIBLE ACADEMIC PROGRAMS/EDUCATIONAL GOALS

Federal regulations require students receiving federal student aid to be enrolled in and make progress toward an **eligible program and educational goal**. Refer to the lists below of Eligible Programs/Educational Goals and Ineligible Programs/Educational Goals.

If enrolled in an ineligible program OR educational goal, students are not eligible for most types of financial aid (grants, loans, work-study). However, if otherwise qualified, students in an ineligible program or educational goal may be eligible for a fee waiver.

All Associate Degrees (AA/AS/AS-T) are financial aid eligible programs (even though they are not listed below).

INELIGIBLE COURSES

All Non-Credit/Adult Education (i.e. course numbers 200-299) coursework is NOT eligible for financial aid.

All remedial courses below the secondary level are NOT eligible for financial aid (e.g. *ESL-302A*, *MATH-301*, *MATH-372*, *MATH-372L*, *MATH-376*, *MATH-376L*, *READ-360*). However, a student can receive financial aid for up to 30 attempted units of remedial courses that are not below the secondary level. Additional remedial courses attempted after the 30-unit limit are not eligible for financial aid.
